HISTORIC STRUCTURE



108 East Maumee, Adrian

WHEREAS, historic structures are not only tangible evidence of important national history, but tell the stories of generations of citizens of Lenawee County and their triumph and tragedies as well; and

WHEREAS, the Lenawee Historical Society created its “Historic Structures” program to identify and celebrate places in Lenawee County, Michigan, that connect people to their individual and collective heritage, and to work toward creating an environment that will support the preservation and rehabilitation of historic buildings and neighborhoods, celebrate economic development of sites, and manage change in communities; and

WHEREAS, 108 East Maumee Street in downtown Adrian is a fine example of a typical storefront dating from about 1863; and

WHEREAS, the building was home to a variety of businesses including a hardware store, a confectionary, a jewelry store, and a clothing store, all examples of the stores found in a downtown so characteristic of Adrian;

THEREFORE, the directors of the Lenawee Historical Society do hereby PROCLAIM 108 East Maumee Street in Adrian as an HISTORIC STRUCTURE in Lenawee County this 1st day of November 2020.
