***448 State Street, Adrian***

***WHEREAS, historic structures are not only tangible evidence of important national history, but tell the stories of generations of citizens of Lenawee County and their triumph and tragedies as well; and***

***WHEREAS, the Lenawee Historical Society created its “Historic Structures” program to identify and celebrate places in Lenawee County, Michigan, that connect people to their individual and collective heritage, and to work toward creating an environment that will support the preservation and rehabilitation of historic buildings and neighborhoods, celebrate economic development of sites, and manage change in communities; and***

***WHEREAS, 448 State Street is a fine example of a rectangular Greek Revival structure with a brick foundation that dates to around 1844; and***

***WHEREAS, 448 State Street is one of the oldest houses in Adrian; and***

***WHEREAS, much of the home’s original interior has been preserved, including plaster, brass door hardware, and fixtures;***

***THEREFORE, the directors of the Lenawee Historical Society do hereby PROCLAIM 448 State Street in Adrian as an HISTORIC STRUCTURE in Lenawee County this 1st day of November 2020.***
